

1932 BUGATTI TYPE 55

1959 LISTER COSTIN CHEVROLET

- ◆ *Maintained by marque specialist Rex Woodgate*
- ◆ *Successful entrant at Monaco Historique, Le Mans Classic, Goodwood Revival & Mille Miglia*




1894 PEUGEOT TYPE 5

- ◆ *An amazing survivor from the dawn of motoring*
- ◆ *Highly original, matching numbers with Daimler V-twin*
- ◆ *Exceptional restoration by veteran expert Tim Moore*
- ◆ *Entrant in the 1894 Paris - Rouen race, recognised as the worlds first motor race*



1973 FERRARI 365 GTB/4 DAYTONA SPIDER

- ◆ *3,800 miles from new*
- ◆ *Believed to be the only example presented in Marrone Colorado with Beige Scuro interior*
- ◆ *Ferrari Classiche Certified*





1963 PORSCHE T6B 356 CARRERA 2GT

- ◆ *1963 Tour de France entry at the hands of Eddy Meert & Wim de Jonghe & winner of the 1964 12 Hours of Hury*
- ◆ *One of 16 examples of the ultimate specification 2 Litre, 4 Cam competition 356*
- ◆ *Beautifully prepared & a highly successful past participant on the Tour Auto*



1934 TALBOT AV105 - AYL 2

◆ *The famous Dr Roth Brooklands car* ◆ *Eligible for the worlds greatest historic rallies & race events including
The Flying Scotsman, Alpine Trial, Goodwood Revival & Le Mans Classic*
